



## A NEW VIEW TO LEARN

#### **DIGITAL LEARNING**

With the threat posed by the Covid-19 pandemic last year, Samsara The World Academy adopted 'The New View of Learning & Teaching '.We started smart virtual classes which enabled learning and replaced the traditional methods of teaching using blackboards and chalks and learning from textbooks. We used a blended and integrated approach to the learning process. This trend in education made learning more engaging and less stressful. The virtual classes enhanced the experience of the students and

learning occurred in real-time. The interactive nature of digital learning stimulated their senses and expanded their knowledge base. Virtual competitions & events were organised which gave a new way to our students. Online competitions provided an opportunity for various participants to gain more experience, demonstrate their knowledge & skills, analyse and evaluate themselves. It gave them a platform to showcase their talent, build confidence and take a notch forward towards achieving great things in life.

### THE FOUNDATIONAL YEARS

### THE EXERCISES OF PRACTICAL LIFE

Activities that directly help children to become independent in their immediate environment. Through the activities done, there is a great development and refinement of fine motor skills. Children achieve eye-hand co-ordination, independence, self-confidence, self-reliance, a sense of order and care, concentration, one on one communication and above all they are prepared for language and arithmetic.






### THE SENSORIAL ACTIVITIES


Meant for training the five senses - visual, olfactory, auditory, gustatory and tactile. During the early and more sensitive periods of a child's life, he/she uses the 5 senses to categorize the huge source of unclassified data gathered from their environment. All activities are self-corrective. Sensorial materials also help adults to identify whether hearing problem or colour blindness exists in any child under their care.

### THE ARITHMETIC MATERIAL

The emphasis here is on the value of the digit, and the place it occupies in a number. A child learns by handling quantities and by counting in ones, tens, the power of tens and multiples of tens. The child grasps the concept of the quantity of each number before rote counting.

One-to-one correspondence, the value of zero, greater and smaller quantities are some of the important concepts, in number work done by the child through a very simple and organized activities.





During preparatory years we work under the Montessori paradigm, on a curriculum that uses terminologies that are tried and tested by generations of students worldwide. We are keen to keep the purity and essence of Montessori's work, yet we also facilitate research in 'Montessori education'.


Terms that you, as a parent, will hear regarding the framework of the curriculum.

#### THE LANGUAGE MATERIAL

One of the major learning skills is communication. And speech is one of the most important means of communication.

Speech is basically the use of words. The greater a child's mastery of words, the richer will be his/her learning in life. There are 3 basic methods used in learning the language:





### THE PHONIC WORD METHOD

This method is used for teaching words with blends and digraphs, namely phonograms. A blend is a word where two letter sounds come together and are read with their individual sounds remaining intact e.g. words with pl, nd, bl etc. Digraphs are words where two letter sounds come together to make a new sound, e.g. words with sh, ch, ph, th, ee, oo etc.

In the Phonic Word Method, letter - sound relationships are learnt in the context of words which they apply through phonic drill and practice. By the time our child turns 4, he/she becomes a confident reader of English sentences and Hindi words without matras.

## THE LOOK AND SAY WORD METHOD

This is used to help the child to build their vocabulary with the help of sight words. Children learn complex non-phonetic words like of green board, window, tubelight, switch, not by spellings and rote but by patterns through continuous sight words in his/her classroom.

### THE PHONETIC METHOD

This is the mainstay method of reading, which relies on the sounds of the letters. The child is introduced to the common sounds of the letters enabling him or her to learn to read by synthesizing the consecutive sounds in a word. Reading, therefore, takes place by lettersound relationships.

#### MUSIC

As essential soul food,
music must be an integral
part of every child's life.
Here, they
will be sensitized and

#### **ART & CRAFT**

Children will be encouraged to see arts and craft not as 'tasks to be completed', but as activities of creativity and consciousness for the environment.

We believe in recycling and reusing all our resources.

Art and craft will compliment academic schedules and routines.



#### **ORIGAMI**

This ancient Japanese art is incorporated along with the children's exposure to other art forms. This exercise initiates the child into experimenting and exploring the dynamics of paper art from a young age.



### KITCHEN BASED ACTIVITIES

### **STORY TELLING**

The Story-telling sessions are held regularly and are not restricted to just classes, but also take place in the library and open arenas. The stories will be absorbed through art and craft, conversation, drama, acting and songs. Through stories we want to inculcate in children good habits, values, good eating habits, health and hygiene, good conduct and knowledge. And above all vivid imagination. The classrooms, library and open arena provide a wide variety of books for children and parents to read and take home. Puppetry and costumes to enact stories both traditional and from immediate surroundings, form a part of our story telling lexicon.



#### **CLAY & POTTERY**

This is a medium, again used

to explore the multi-facets of a child's creativity.

An exercise, not dictated by learning outcomes, but by the experience of creation, and the tactile pleasure of molding a material that simultaneously calms and stimulates the child's inspirations.



### DANCE & CREATIVE MOVEMENT

Incorporating both eastern and western sensibilities, emphasis are on regular dance routines and experimentation, where children are initiated into classical and contemporary music and rhythm.



### SAMSARA PHYSICAL EDUCATION



### **AEROBICS**

Our aim is to develop the child's physical fitness by combining rhythmic aerobic exercises with stretching muscles and strength training. This is through free-hand exercise and dance routines held on a regular basis.



### **YOGA**

Developing the mind, body and spirit in-tandem is an integral part of a child's evolution. Therefore, yoga is being incorporated into the daily curriculum of the school, along with the education of the yoga theory to facilitate the process.



### **TRACK & FIELD**

The sports programme at
Samsara The world Academy
includes athletic activities based
on running, jumping and
throwing, performed on grass &
concrete tracks specially
designed for students. This
strengthens the overall stamina
in a child, enabling them for
better performances and coping
up with competitive
environments.



#### **SKATING**

Skating is an amazing form of self expression. Samsarians have got this privileged of self expression during their skating classes. Many of the national level skaters have been accoladed and figured out till now and laureled for their flair.



### KARATE

Learning and training in Karate at our school help the child not only to be able to defend himself but also prepares the child to face the future with confidence. Our karate classes assimilate many other qualities in our children such as self discipline, control and patience, sharpening memory, physical fitness and coordination of the mind and body.



### **ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION**

Nature is what builds a healthy and happy life; and thus is quintessential in living up an active lifestyle. Extreme emphasis is laid on instilling in children's mind a spirit of enquiry, awareness, responsibility and consciousness towards the environment. This is facilitated through many workshops, outdoor sessions and experiences from nature walk, planting small garden beds.



# REACHING HEIGHTS

As per the new school education system of 5 + 3 + 3 + 4 outlined in NEP 2020, children will spend five years in the foundational stage, 3 years in the preparatory stage, 3 years in the middle stage and 4 years in the secondary stage.

### **FOUNDATIONAL STAGE**

Classes M.B. to 2

### PREPARATORY STAGE

Classes 3 to 5

### THE MIDDLE SCHOOL

Classes 6 to 8.

### THE SENIOR SCHOOL

Classes 9 to 12.

The Middle School and Senior School are adjacent to each other and are a full house of energy and talented students.

### THE FOUNDATIONAL STAGE

The Foundational Stage houses five early years of planned education: The Montessori Blue (Pre-Nursery), Nursery, Kindergarten, One and Two.

### The Montessori Blue Programme

Montessori Blue is four hours long program for the age group of 2 to 3 years. It is based on the respected Montessori paradigm that a child's natural receptivity towards learning is enhanced in an environment prepared with specific learning aids. All material and content provided is of international standard.

### The Nursery Programme

The Nursery program is four hours long program for children from the age of three years to four years. The foundation of this program is based on the principles of free progressive education that is led by a curriculum of arts, science, music and movement. This also creates an atmosphere that

encourages the child's ability to learn a second language, a language other than the mother tongue is gradually added. The base of this program is child led, awakening the child's natural instinct for learning.

### The Kindergarten Programme

The Kindergarten program is a four hours program for children from the age of four years to five years. This program is also based on the principle of free progressive education, led by a curriculum of art, science, music and dance. At this stage, emotional independence is encouraged amongst children. Once again, this program encourages bilingualism in languages other than the mother tongue.

# THE PREPARATORY STAGE

The Preparatory Stage houses Class Three, Four and Five.

In these formative years, Junior School plays an important role in a student's life. Samsara's Junior School represents a promise to deliver quality education that emphasizes the inculcation of a deep-rooted value system. Our educational processes are aimed at empowering the child's intellect and simultaneously supporting their emotional, moral and physical well-being.

We believe in the unique, individual talents of each child and follow an instructional strategy that compliments every child's different learning style. This multi-layered process of integrating and merging curriculum boundaries is the way of Samsara-The World Academy linking a child's learning with real life situations and experiences.

We have developed a new, theme-based, project supported curriculum that ensures multi-dimensional learning for every child and allows us to bring forward latent talent and shape creative thinking. Students learn in multiple ways, like reading, exploring, observing and experimenting with ideas. While textbooks and curriculum goals are extremely relevant in establishing a firm scholastic foundation, it is the interdisciplinary connections that form a holistic education. This process is encouraged by a set of teachers trained for interdisciplinary subject linkages.



The junior school also functions as a community hub for film viewing, theater, music, open house days, student day out activities, and environment and heritage programs. We look forward to creating a school with a clear focus on growth in all aspects of living.

### Classes Sixth, Seventh and Eighth

Our team of steadfast and true-blue educators precisely storify the mainstay of Middle School. Our faculty members are committed to stimulate individual growth in every child homed by Samsara, through academics and character building programs, empowering them to build and live in educative, healthy and culturally enriched societies.

Middle school is the hub for both indoor and outdoor explorations, discussions and deliberations, as well as project work for community and personal development.

Our curriculum in totality opens our Samsara student to a

world of endless possibilities following the guidelines of NEP 2020. We depend on the child's inner curiosity and ability to transcend both physical and mental barriers as an integral approach to learning.

Field trips, excursions, student exchange programs and community appropriate social work allow young students to explore the real world. Our integrated syllabus also encourages children to explore their individual needs and group expectations.

### We hope to create a platform for synchronous and collaborative learning.

As we hope to create a platform for synchronized collaborative learning, information and communication technologies are used extensively. Starting at Middle School, classrooms encourage interaction and co-operation among students, parents and teachers.

We encourage the transmission of the basic skills and concepts, so multimedia computer softwares that lay the foundations for evolved thinking skills and creativity, are facilitated through our available information and communication technologies.

The initial selection of books, textbooks and reading material for students is based on a thorough selection of age appropriate curriculum interventions.

In-house books and journals are created every year to document the journeys that take place at Samsara.

Physical education is provided to all the students irrespective of their genders, it gives an exposure to both individuals. Sports coaching is an important part of our curriculum which encourages them to adopt and maintain healthy active life style.

# SENIOR SCHOOL

### Affiliated with the C.B.S.E. for Classes Nine, Ten, Eleven and Twelve.

The cornerstone of our belief system is that each child must develop an innate understanding and appreciation of her/his abilities, yet be humble about their existence. Samsara The World Academy, in the initial phases of establishing this culture, emphasizes that all children choose at least two activities as propellers towards mental, emotional and physical growth.



# SAFETY GUIDELINES

### GENERAL RULES

- All the school activities for the current session are mentioned in the School Calendar. Please look through it for all updates and upcoming events.
- Our Friday Circular comprises of all important points. Please go through each point for further reinforcement.
- Identity Card (ID Card) is mandatory for every student.
- It is mandatory for parents/guardians to bring a 'Collection Card' always when they come to collect the ward at dispersal time or during school hours.
- House Uniform is mandatory on every Friday for the students of Grade 3 to 12.
- Please be considerate and attend every P.T.M (Parent-Teacher-Meet) without failure.
- Pick up school phone calls as school authorities call only in cases of emergency or when it is unavoidable.
- O Don't send your ward to school when he/she is sick.
- It is mandatory to submit a Transfer Certificate, Medical Certificate, Report Card and Aadhar Card's copy and Valid Address Proof at the time of admission.
- The monthly fee will be deposited in ICICI Bank or online transaction on all working days. No cash is accepted.
- The School gate will open at a fixed time 8:15 A.M. and 2:30 P.M. for classes 1 to 12; and at 1:10 P.M. for classes M.B. to K.G. due to security reasons.
- Kindly send tiffin, water bottles, sanitizer etc. along with the children. Lunch boxes, water bottles or any eatables are not allowed once the child enters the school premises.
- Entry of parents in the school corridors and towards the classrooms is prohibited. Kindly adhere to it.
- Parents will be allowed in the school premises only if they carry the collection card of their ward.
- Please pay the school fee by the 10th of every month to avoid inconvenience.
- The name of the child will be struck off if the fee is overdue for three months/no attendance for 03 consecutive months/not appeared in internal exam falling in these consecutive 3 months.
- Kindly buy text books, stationery and uniform from the open market. School does not have such facilities in the campus.
- It is mandatory for the children to submit leave application before hand. Kindly e-mail the leave application to the concerned teacher and to the school email address in case of emergency.
- Leave will not be granted for any reason during the examination. In case of medical issues, it is necessary to appear in the retest after submitting the medical certificate. On failure a re-test will not be conducted further.
- Parents are requested to adhere to the meeting days/time with the Principal Tuesday and Saturday from 12 noon to 2 p.m.
   ONLY and to meet teachers and admin a prior appointment to be taken from the concerned person.
- Loitering around the school campus after the school hours is strictly prohibited. Kindly keep a check on your ward and ask them to get back straight home after the school gets over.
- No mobile phones are allowed in the school. If any student is caught carrying a mobile phone during surprise checks, it will be taken away and will only be returned at the end of the academic session.
- Facebook/Whatsapp /Twitter/Instagram or any other social media sites are not to be accessed by the children. Please have a close vigil. Parental guidance is needed at all times.
- Parents are requested to cooperate with the guards at the main gate when they ask for Collection/ID cards. Please, respect the school rules as they are implemented for the safety and security of your children.
- Parents are requested to have a candid interaction with their child/children regularly. It is very important to maintain healthy and friendly relations with children and to get updated about their day-to-day activities and environment.
- It is mandatory to wear mask and follow COVID-19 protocols.

# SAFETY GUIDELINES

### TRANSPORT RULES

- The School will not be responsible for any mishappening if you avail private transport for plying the child.
- Please follow the traffic rules and drive on the right side of the road to avoid any mishap.
- It has been observed that the parents are using the wrong gate to drop off their wards. Walkers will use only Gate no. 2. Gate no. 1 is strictly meant for school transport.
- An advisory to the parents who are sending their wards in private vehicles:
  - ✓ Please have a close contact with the drivers.
  - ✓ Take their alternative mobile numbers. Also, share your mobile numbers with them.
  - ✓ Check the vehicle's fitness.
  - ✓ The vehicle must have a first-aid box and a fire extinguisher (if it runs on CNG).
  - ✓ Check the speed at which they drive.
  - ✓ Ask/demand for police verification of the driver and the helper.
  - ✓ Request them to have a lady helper (maid) with them when the children are in the vehicle.
  - ✓ Check the code of conduct of the drivers.
  - ✓ Be very firm that they should follow the traffic rules.
- O Students are not allowed to come to school riding a two-wheeler or driving a four wheeler. If any student will be seen do in g so, the vehicle's keys will be confiscated and will be given to the nearest police station.
- The Rider and the co-rider must wear helmets as there are serious hazards of not wearing one while riding the vehicle. Kindly adhere to the traffic rules at all given times.
