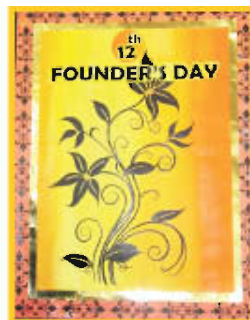

The entire team of support staff was thanked by the Principal and she expressed her gratitude to them.

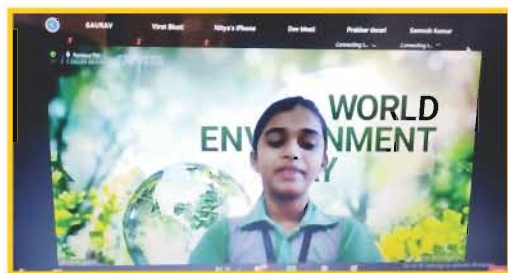


# ENVIRONMENT DAY
