

The green colour of the house symbolises that we all are down to earth. It represents new beginnings and growth. It also signifies renewal and abundance.


Aristotelians not only participated in various competitions with great enthusiasm but also won some of them.

We, the Shakespeareans are on our way to spreading love and positivity. Our house colour 'Red' symbolises passion, love, and courage. It represents the courage to try new things.




Samsara-The World Academy celebrated Hindi Diwas on 14th September 2023 by organising a special assembly.


National Reading Day •-----




Samsara-The World Academy conducted special online assembly on 26 July, 2023 in remembrance of Kargil Vijay Diwas.

The resource persons guided how to provide quality education as it is a cornerstone of children's well-being.





Our facilitators inferred numerous classroom activities and shared their valuable experiences with other team members.








Green Hydrogen as Future Renewable Energy



The war in Ukraine has caused a global energy crisis due to the lack of fossil fuels. This has led to an unprecedented rise in the price of natural gas and coal, causing Europe to import much more liquefied natural gas than usual, with the attendant problem of worsening climate change. Decarbonising the planet is one of the goals that countries around the world have set for 2050. To achieve this, decarbonising the production of an element like hydrogen, giving rise to green hydrogen, is one of the keys as this is currently responsible for more than 2 % of total global CO2 emissions.

Green Hydrogen is produced using electrolysis of water with electricity generated by renewable energy. The carbon intensity ultimately depends on the carbon neutrality of the source of electricity.

Hydrogen is the most abundant chemical element in nature. As noted by the International Energy Agency (IEA), the global demand for hydrogen for use as a fuel has tripled since 1975 and reached 100 million tonnes a year in 2023. In addition, green hydrogen is a clean energy source that only emits water vapour and leaves no residue in the air, unlike coal and oil. Hydrogen as a fuel is


a reality in countries like the United States, Russia, China, France and Germany. Others like Japan is going even further and aspire to become a hydrogen economy.

India has launched the National Green Hydrogen Mission with an outlay of Rs. 19,744 crores with a target of 5MMT production capacity of Green Hydrogen per annum. In conclusion, Green Hydrogen has enormous potential to decarbonize several sectors, reduce carbon emissions and achieve energy independence.

India has set its sight on becoming energy independent by 2047 and achieving Net Zero by 2070. To achieve this target, increasing renewable energy use across all economic spheres is central to India's Energy Transition. Green Hydrogen is considered a promising alternative for enabling this transition. Hydrogen can be utilized for long-duration storage of renewable energy, replacement of fossil fuels in industry, clean transportation, and potentially also for decentralized power generation, aviation, and marine transport. The National Green Hydrogen Mission was approved by the Union Cabinet on 4 January 2022.



पर प्रयत्न करने पर उसे वह विषय याद न आया।





छोटी और सनसनीखेज सामग्री में फँस जाना आसान है। लेकिन अगर आप चिंतित हैं कि यह आपके ध्यान को नुकसान पहुंचा सकता है, तो आपको चिंतित होना चाहिए। इस बात के ठोस सबूत हैं कि हमारे ध्यान पर इतनी सारी माँगें हमें और अधिक तनावग्रस्त कर देती हैं, और यह कि अंतहीन सामाजिक तुलना हमें अपने बारे में बूरा महसूस कराती है।

बेहतर मानसिक स्वास्थ्य के लिए किताब पढ़ें।


