
Respecting the ethics of the economic fabric of society and



While addressing the audience our Managing Director stressed that the presence of parents is more important than showering the children with presents.



Our revered management applauded the efforts of the students and planted saplings along with the staff members.








Depiction of Save Soil



history", then comes our Social Science Lab and Conceptual bulletin boards etc.
























Yoga Club





En octobre 1789, Pain Riot-

Les pénuries alimentaires et les prix élevés ont déclenché une explosion de colère populaire dans les villes.

SYSTÈME ÉDUCATIF FRANÇAIS

Le système éducatif français est particulièrement connu pour être compliqué en ce qui concerne les différentes catégories et types de diplômes et de tests. Les écoles françaises sont connues pour être strictement éducatives. Ce qui signifie qu'ils n'ont pas beaucoup d'activités parascolaires au moins liées à l'école (ils n'ont pas beaucoup de financement en raison du faible ou pas de frais de scolarité), pas de danses scolaires ou d'événements majeurs, pas d'affiches comme vous voyez dans d'autres écoles en

Europe. Il est très courant en France de répéter une année scolaire si les élèves n'obtiennent pas les notes moyennes dont ils ont besoin pour réussir les cours.

Le système éducatif français comprend trois étapes : l'enseignement primaire, l'enseignement secondaire et l'enseignement supérieur.

ENSEIGNEMENT PRIMAIRE

Bien que les garderies et la maternelle ne soient pas obligatoires, à partir de 6 ans, tous les enfants doivent s'inscrire à l'école. L'école primaire se compose de cinq années d'études, à partir de l'âge 6-11.

ENSEIGNEMENT SUPÉRIEUR

Après le lycée, les élèves choisissent soit un diplôme professionnel, soit un diplôme académique.

ENSEIGNEMENT SECONDAIRE

Après l'école primaire, les élèves passent à l'école secondaire, qui se divise en deux étapes :

- Le collège (collège), est composé de quatre années d'études, pour les élèves âgés de onze à quinze ans. Les étudiants reçoivent un « brevet des collèges » à la fin de leurs études.
- Le lycée (lycée) pour les trois dernières années de l'enseignement secondaire. Les étudiants passent ensuite un examen pour obtenir le diplôme de baccalauréat (bac) (bac).

DIPLÔMES PROFESSIONNELS:

Le DUT (diplôme universitaire de technologie) et le BTS (brevet de technicien supérieur) sont des diplômes de deux ans axés sur la technologie. Les cours BTS sont dispensés par les lycées, tandis que les DUT sont délivrés par les universités. Un DUT ou BTS peut être suivi d'une année supplémentaire d'études qualifiante, conduisant à une « licence professionnelle ».

DIPLÔMES ACADÉMIQUES:

Il existe en France trois types d'établissements d'enseignement supérieur : les universités, les Grandes écoles et les écoles spécialisées.

UNIVERSITÉS

Les universités sont des établissements publics qui offrent des diplômes universitaires, techniques et professionnels à tout étudiant qui a obtenu un « baccalauréat » ou son équivalent à l'étranger. Les études universitaires mènent à des diplômes dans de nombreux domaines. Les diplômes sont trois niveaux différents de réalisation

- 1. Licence
- 2. Maître
- 3. Doctorat

GRANDES ÉCOLES

Les « grandes écoles » sont des établissements publics et privés sélectifs. Ils sont semblables aux universités, mais offrent généralement un programme d'études plus spécialisé de trois ans, dans des matières telles que l'ingénierie, les affaires ou l'administration publique. Les étudiants sont admis aux Grandes écoles en fonction de leurs résultats à



पर्यावरण सुरक्षा क्या है?

मानव गतिविधियों से जुड़े परिवर्तनों से पारिस्थितिक तंत्र और उनके घटक भागों की सुरक्षा तथा पारिस्थितिक तन्त्र और उनके घटक भागों में अवांछित प्राकृतिक परिवर्तनों की रोकथाम करने का नाम है।

उपसंहार पर्यावरण संरक्षण व्यक्तियों, संगठनों और सरकारों द्वारा प्राकृतिक पर्यावरण की रक्षा करने का काम है। इसका उद्देश्य प्राकृतिक संसाधनों और मौजूदा प्राकृतिक वातावरण का संरक्षण करना है, और जहाँ संभव हो, क्षति और पुननिर्माण उपायों पर ध्यान इंगित करना है। पारिस्थितिक दृष्टिकोण से, मनुष्यों को पारिस्थितिकी तंत्र का एक अमिन्न अंग माना जाता है।


